16. COUNCILLORS REPORTS

a). Moor Pond Wood Steering Committee

Three working days were held over the Easter weekend. The outlet to the pond had now been located. Tree tagging will continue next weekend.

A history walk, arranged by NCC, will take place on the 19th May and a national archaeology day has also been arranged for the 19th July.

b). Parish Paths Partnership

An application had been submitted to NCC for funding but no response had yet been received.

c). Playing Field

The ROSPA safety inspection was completed. The official report is still awaited but verbal confirmation has been given that no serious defects had been identified. Some fencing repairs are still required. Dog fouling signs are being erected at the entrance to the woods.

Quotations are still awaited for excavation work for the Skate Boarding Park. It was noted that the Parish Council still needs to formally approve the scheme once all funding streams have all been confirmed.

Tipping of rubbish behind the gardens of properties in Linby Lane had been noted. It was agreed that the Parish Council will write to all residents. The chairman will approve a suitable form of words.

The goalmouth was becoming waterlogged due to surface compaction. Grass spiking will be arranged.
