Ian Griffiths advised that the verge area south of 63 Mansfield Rd is overgrown with nettles, Cllr Colin Womble advised that this is the responsibility of NCC.

Cllr Womble reported that the gullies on Mansfield Rd have now been cleared.

Margaret Kerr raised the proposed changes for Forest Lane. Phil Gower explained the measures which have been put forward by Highways. Questions were raised concerning double white lines leading to the bend, the possibility of repeater signs for 30mph (Phil advised these are not possible), the advantages and disadvantages of friction surfacing on the bend and the reasons for these proposals in light of the coroner's report not yet being available.

The issue of pavement improvements were raised on Forest Lane and Linby Lane, but were not deemed as priority bearing in mind the funding constraints.

Parishioner Lesley Mills asked whether PPC would be making a donation to Linby PC to help fund resources required concerning the proposed GBC Housing developments.

Margaret Kerr passed on her appreciation for the hard work that went into this year's bonfire event.

It was noted that the marquee on the Griffins Head field appears to be a permanent installation and it was questioned whether planning permission had been sought? Clerk to enquire with the Landlord.
